ORDINANCE NO. 40 -40

To change the name of Dawson Avenue between Caroline Avenue and Delmar Drive.

Whereas, there are two avenues in the City of Bexley bearing the name of Dawson Avenue, the first thereof extending from Main Street to Broad Street, and the other extending from Caroline Avenue to Delmar Drive, and it is desirable that the name of one thereof shall be changed so as to leave only one street bearing said name, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEALEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the name of Dawson Avenue extending from Caroline Avenue to Delmar Drive be and the same is changed to the name of North Stanbery Avenue.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
