## ORDINANCE NO. 42-40

To amend Section 3 of Ordinance No. 10-38, determining to proceed with the improvement of Francis Avenue from Mound Street to Livingston Avenue, passed February 8th, 1938, and repassed June 11, 1940.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEALEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Three-fourths of all members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That Section 3 of Ordinance No. 10-38, determining to proceed with the improvement of Francis Avenue from Mound Street to Livingston Avenue, by grading, paving, curbing and constructing necessary sewers, drains and water lines, passed February 8th, 1938, and re-passed June 11th, 1940, be amended to read as follows:-

Section 3. That the whole cost of said improvement less one-fiftieth thereof, and the cost of intersections, and less the cost of said fire hydrants, shall be assessed in proportion to the benefits which may result from the improvement upon the following described lots and lands, to-wit: All lots and lands bounding and abutting upon the proposed improvement, which said lots and lands are hereby determined to be especially benefitted by said improvement in an amount not less than the cost thereof, and the cost of said improvement shall include the expense of the preliminary and other surveys and of printing and publishing the notices, resolutions and ordinances required, and the serving of said notices, the cost of construction, together with interest on notes and bonds issued in anticipation of the collection of deferred assessments, and all other necessary expenditures.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
