ORDINANCE NO. 43-40

By Mr. Harlor

Providing for the improvement and repair of Drexel Avenue from Main Street to Dale Avenue, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:
Three-fourths of all members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That Drexel Avenue from Main Street to Dale Avenue shall be improved and repaired by constructing a concrete foundation in that portion thereof where the car tracks of The Columbus and Southern Ohio Electric Company are being removed, and laying a brick surface thereon and repairing the other portion thereof where needed, as indicated by the city engineers, all in accordance with the plans, estimates and specifications prepared by the engineers and on file in the office of the Mayor, which are hereby approved.

Section 2. That the entire cost of said repairs shall be paid by the city and the sum of \$13,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the general fund for that purpose.

Section 3. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract for said improvement and repairs, after advertisement according to law.

Section 4. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, and safety, taid emergency being that said street is and will be in an impassable condition and unsafe for public traffic unless said repairs are promptly made, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
