## ORDINANCE NO. 45-40

Appointing an assistant clerk of council for the purpose of serving notices, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE SITY OF BEALEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Frank A. Hamilton, be and he is hereby appointed assistant clerk of council for the year 1940 for the purpose of serving notices of the passage of resolutions and other proceedings for improvements and such other notices and reports as are required by law to be served upon property owners for which services he shall receive the sum of \$5.00 per day for each day actually engaged in such service, and shall be reimbursed for his expenses. Said payments shall be included as a part of the cost of the improvements for which said notices and reports shall be served.

Section 2. The sum of \$ \frac{100}{200} is hereby appropriated from the general fund for the above purposes, which funds shall be reimbursed from any monies provided for the cost of the improvements for which said notices and reports shall be served.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, Health and safety, said emergency being that certain improvements are in progress for which notices must be served at once, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
