

## ORDINANCE NO. 65-40

By Mr. Metz

Appointing an additional Assistant Clerk of Council  
for the purpose of serving notices, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BERLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That C. E. Hopkins be  
and he is hereby appointed as Assistant Clerk of Council for  
the period ending December 31st, 1940, for the purpose of  
serving notices of the passage of resolutions and other pro-  
ceedings of council and such other notices and reports as are  
required by law to be served upon property owners, for which  
services he shall receive the sum of \$5.00 per day for each  
day actually engaged in such service, and shall be reimbursed  
for his expenses incurred therein. Said payments shall be  
included as part of the cost of the improvement or improvement  
for which said notices and reports shall be served.

Section 2. Said payments shall be made from the sum  
heretofore approved from the general fund by Ordinance No.  
45-40, and said funds shall be reimbursed from any moneys pro-  
vided for the cost of the improvements for which said notices  
and reports shall be served.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance  
necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,  
health and safety, said emergency being that certain improve-  
ments are in progress for which notices must be served at once  
and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
