

ORDINANCE NO. 2-41

By Mr. Harlor

Fixing salaries of certain officers and employees for the year 1941, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the salaries of the following officers and employees of the City for the year 1941 be and the same are hereby fixed as follows:

Superintendent of Building	\$75.00 per month
Asst. " " "	180.00 " "
Secretary to the Mayor and Auditor and various administrative depts.	110.00 " " for the first six months & 115.00 per month for the last six months of the year.

Section 2. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, for which reason the same shall go into immediate force and effect.
