ORDINANCE NO. 3-41

Withdrawing that portion of Ruhl Avenue east of Stanwood Road from street improvement proceedings.

Whereas, on the 12th day of March, 1940 the Council of the City of Bexley duly passed Ordinance No. 15-40, determining to proceed with the improvement of Ruhl Avenue from Cassingham Road to the east corporation line in the manner therein described in cooperation with the Work Projects Administration, and

Whereas, after said improvement was undertaken said Work Projects Administration declined to proceed with the improvement of that part of Ruhl Avenue lying east of the east line of Stanwood Road, being a distance of approximately 124 feet, for the reason that said street ran into a dead end and would serve no public purpose, for which reason it is desirable to withdraw that portion of Ruhl Avenue from street improvement proceedings, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEKLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That that portion of Ruhl Avenue extending from the east line of Stanwood Road to the east corporation line be not improved at this time under the proceedings for street improvement as authorized by said Ordinance No. 15-40.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
