RESOLUTION NO. 9-41

By Mr. Hertz

Providing for sidewalks on Roosevelt Avenue between Broad Street and Fair Avenue.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, STATE OF OHIO:

That sidewalks shall be constructed on both sides of Roosevelt Avenue from Broad Street to Fair Avenue of the character and in the manner following: Said sidewalks shall be constructed of concrete in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor heretofore adopted by council and now on file in the office of the Mayor; they shall be four feet in width with a cross slope of 3/8ths of an inch per foot and shall be placed with the inside edge, being the edge next to the lot line, 7 1/2 feet from the back edge of the curb, and said inside edge shall be 4 inches above said curbs and parallel thereto.

The foot of the terrace slope shall not extend into the street beyond the property line.

That the Clerk of Council be and he is hereby directed to cause a written notice of the passage of this resolution to be served as required by law.

Said notice shall contain, in addition to other matters required by law, notice that if said sidewalks are not constructed within the time therein directed the Mayor in having the same done at the expense of the respective property owners may have said work done in cooperation with the Work Projects Administration of the United States, or by contract entered into according to law.
