Wheaton, three disinterested free-holders of said city, be and they are hereby appointed a B oard to estimate the assessment of such cost on the lots and lands to be charged therewith, as set North in an Ordinance No. 54-40, to improve said street, passed August 13th, 1940, in proportion as nearly as may be to the benefits which may result from the improvement to the several lots or parcels of land so assessed and report to this council the said estimated assessment.
