

ORDINANCE NO. 14-41

Correcting assessments levied for the improvement of the alleys hereinafter named.

Whereas, by Ordinance No. 63-40, passed on the 22nd day of October, 1940, special assessments were levied for the improvement of the following alleys, by grading and paving with concrete and constructing necessary drains, to-wit:

- (a) The first alley south of Astor Avenue, from Vernon Road to Roosevelt Avenue,
- (b) The first alley north of Astor Avenue, from Remington Road to Vernon Road,
- (c) The first alley south of Main Street, from Chelsea Avenue to the first alley east of Chelsea Avenue,
- (d) That part of the alley between Brentwood Road and Bexley Park Road extending westerly from Remington Road a distance of 100 ft.
- (e) The first alley east of Roosevelt Avenue extending from the north line of Bexley Highlands Amended Addition to Powell Avenue,
- (f) The first alley east of Cassidy Road from Maryland Avenue to Ruhl Avenue,

in the respective amounts in said ordinance set forth, which ordinance has been certified to the County Auditor and said respective assessments have been by him entered upon the tax duplicate, and

Whereas, by sole reason of a mathematical error in calculating the cost of said improvement causing said assessments to have been levied in a larger total amount than the actual cost of said improvement, which mistake Council hereby determines should be remedied by a proportionate reduction of the amounts of said respective assessments as contained in said ordinance, and the engineers having re-computed the respective amounts thereof, as hereinafter shown, so as to correct said excessive levies, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the assessments heretofore levied by

said Ordinance No. 63-40 against the respective premises therein described, and in the amounts therein shown, for said alley improvement, be and the same are hereby corrected in accordance with the re-computation thereof by said engineers by reducing the same against said respective properties to the following amounts, to-wit:
