

ORDINANCE NO. 15-41

Appointing Assistant Clerk of Council for the purpose of serving notices during the year 1941.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That C. E. Hopkins be and he is hereby appointed as Assistant Clerk of Council for the period ending December 31st, 1941, for the purpose of serving notices of the passage of resolutions and other proceedings of council and such other notices and reports as are required by law to be served upon property owners, for which services he shall receive the sum of \$5.00 per day for each day actually engaged in such service, and shall be reimbursed for his expenses incurred therein. Said payments shall be included as part of the cost of the improvement or improvements for which said notices and reports shall be served.

Section 2. That the sum of \$200.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the payment of the compensation of said Assistant Clerk, and said fund shall be reimbursed from any moneys provided for the cost of the improvements for which said notices and reports shall be served.

Section 3. This ordinance shall go into effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
