ORDINANCE HO. 18-41

To levy special assessments for the improvement of Powell Avenue from Drexel Avenue to Dawson Avenue.

BE IT ORLAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of improving Powell Avenue from Drexel Avenue to Dawson Avenue by grading and paving the roadway thereof with concrete base and bituminous concrete surface, constructing concrete curbs and gutters, and the necessary drains to provide drainage for said improvement, and constructing sidewalks, in the aggregate amounts of \$100.00, as reported to this Council on the 9th day of January, 1941, by the Board heretofore appointed to estimate said assessments, notice of the filing of which assessments has been given as required by law, be and the seme is bereby adopted and confirmed, and that there be end is horeby levied and assessed upon the lots and lands bounding, fronting and abutting upon said improvement the several amounts reported as aforesaid, which as essments, together with the description of said lots and lands are now on file in the office of the Clerk of this Council, and which assessments are in proportion to the special benefits, and are not in excess of the special benefits to said property, and are not in excess of any statutory limitation, said assessments, together with the description of said lots and lands, ce as follows: to-wit:

Section 2. That the total assessment against each lot or purcel of land shall be payable in cash within thirty days from and after the passage of this ordinance, or at the option of the owner, in five annual installments with interest at the same rate as shall be borne by the bonds to be issued in anticiprion of the collection of the ste, to-wit: 3 %. All cash payments shall be made to the Auditor of taid City of Bexley. All assessments and installments thereof remaining unpaid at the expiration of said thirty days shall be certified by the Clerk of this Council to the County Auditor, as provided by law to be by him placed on the tax duplicate and collected as other taxes are collected.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
