Authorizing the purchase of a street roller for the Department of Public Service, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COULCIL OF THE CITY OF BEALEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Scetion 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of one gasoline driven 5 - 10 ton Tandem Street Roller at a cost not to exceed \$3700.00, and to exchange thereon the 3 ton Galion Fordson Roller now belonging to the city, which said roller is estimated not to exceed \$500.00 in value.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement had according to law. The Sum of \$3700.00 is hereby appropriated from the general fund for the purpose aforesaid.

Section 5. This ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said Department is in immediate need of said roller in the construction and repair of certain streets, which projects are now underway, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
