

ORDINANCE NO. 45-41

By Mr. Altmaier

To establish the grade of the first alley east of Chelsea Avenue from Mound Street to the first alley south of Main Street.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the permanent grade of the first alley east of Chelsea Avenue from Mound Street to the first alley south of Main Street be and the same is hereby established, as follows, to-wit:

East Side:

Beginning at the north line of East Mound Street in Bexley Annex addition, at station 9 - 95 and at elevation 99.58; thence northerly on a 0.40% ascending grade to the south line of the first alley south of Main Street and at station 15 - 07 and at elevation 101.63.

West Side:

The grade of the west side shall be the same as the grade on the east side.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
