

## ORDINANCE NO. 57-41

Approving bill of Burgess &amp; Niple.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the bill of Burgess & Niple, bearing date of July 25th, 1941, for engineering services rendered in connection with final settlement of the sewer rental rates payable to the City of Columbus in the sum of \$300.00 be and the same is hereby approved and ordered paid.

Section 2. The sum of \$300.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the payment thereof.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
