## ORDINANCE NO. 58-41

Approving bill of Harley E. Peters, City Solicitor, and appropriating money for payment thereof.

DE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the bill of Harley E. Peters, City Solicitor, in the sum of \$500.00 for legal services rendered in connection with the Columbus ordinance fixing rates to be charged Bexley and other suburban areas for disposal of sanitary sewage and threatened litigation resulting therefrom, be and the same is hereby approved, and the sum of \$500.00 is appropriated from General Fund for the payment thereof.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
