ORDINANCE NO. 63-41

Authorizing the use of a School Safety Patrol.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO Section 1. That a School Safety Patrol as may be organized under the direction of the Board of Education of the Bexley City School District for the purpose of assisting school children at street crossings, be and is hereby authorized to operate such patrol on the public streets of the city by the stationing of its members at such street intersections as may be determined by sai? Board of Education.

Section 2. Each member of said School Safety Patrol shall be not less than twelve years of age, and when on duty he shall be equipped with a badge designating membership in such patrol, and with a white belt of the style commonly known as "Sam Brown Belt", and with a signal comprised of a red flag, or banner, attached to a pole not less than six feet in length, and having the word "STOP" thereon in white letters not less than Bix inches in height, said pole and banner to be extended from the curb cross-wise of the street to designate the time or times when shoool children shall cross the street, and to be held parallel to the curb to warn such children against crossing such street. Any member of such patrol who shall be placed at a street intersection where there is a traffic signal light shall conform his signals to those of such traffic signal light, and shall not direct traffic contrary to such traffic signal light.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
