Providing for the office of assistant superintendent of streets and declaring an emergency.

BE IT CADAINAD BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEALEY, STATE OF OHIO:
Three-fourths of all members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the office of assistant superintendent of streets is hereby created, which position shall be exempt from the classified service. An assistant superintendent of streets shall be appointed by the Nayor and confirmed by Council for the remainder of the year beginning November 15th, 1941 and ending December 31, 1941, and thereafter such appointment shall be for a term of one year or until his successor is appointed and qualified. The salary shall be at the rate of \$225.00 per month for such portion of 1941 as such assistant shall serve, payable monthly, and the salary shall thereafter be as lixed by vouncil. He shall assist the superintendent of streats in the performance of the duties prescribed in Section 2(a) of Ordinance No. 93-31, and shall perform such other duties as may hereafter be required by Council. The sum of \$337.50 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the above purpose.

Section 2. This ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the Superintendent of attests is in poor condition of health and unable to attend to the necessary duties of his office in connection with said improvements now in progress, and sale ordinance shall go into immediate force of effect.
