

## ORDINANCE NO. 71-41

By Mr. Stackhouse

Providing for payment of bill of The Jennings-Lawrence  
Company.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF  
OHIO:

Section 1. That the bill of The Jennings-Lawrence Company  
for the survey, description and plat of the Jeffrey tract at  
Clifton Avenue and Parkview Avenue, Bexley, Ohio, in the sum of  
\$182.60 be paid, and that said sum of \$182.60 is hereby approp-  
riated from the General Fund for that purpose.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in  
force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
