

ORDINANCE NO. 72-41

Approving bills of The Jennings-Lawrence Company, and authorizing payment thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the bills of The Jennings-Lawrence Company, engineers, for services rendered on improvement of Elm Avenue from Roosevelt Avenue to Gould Road, of February 17, 1941 in the sum of \$78.30 and of August 1st, 1941 in the sum of \$88.50, be and are hereby approved, and the Auditor is authorized to pay the same.

Section 2. The sum of \$166.80 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the payment of the foregoing bills.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
