

ORDINANCE NO. 1-42 ✓

Fixing salaries of certain officers and employees hereinafter set forth, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the salaries of the following officers and employees of the City are hereby fixed at the following amounts per year, payable monthly, until the same shall be otherwise fixed by council, to-wit:

Superintendent of Building	\$2400.00
Superintendent of Parks	2100.00
Secretary to the Mayor and Auditor and various administrative departments	1500.00

Section 2. This ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, for which reason the same shall go into immediate force and effect.
