Approving bonds of certain officials.

LE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BENLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the bond of A. C. Kuhn, elected and qualified Justice of the Peace of Bexley Township for the term beginning January 1st, 1942 and ending December 31st, 1945, which said bond is in the sum of \$1000.00 with Commercial Casualty Insurance Company, as surety thereon, and bearing date of January, 1, 1942; also the bond of van Purcell, the elected and qualified Constable of Hexley Township, for the term beginning January 1st, 1942 and ending December 51st, 1943, which said bond bears date of January 1, 1942, and is in the sum of \$1000.00 with Commercial casualty Company as surety thereon, be and the same are hereby approved.

Be It Burther Ordained that said bonds shall be deposited with the Auditor of the City of Bexley, and that said Auditor shall notify the Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas of this County in writing of the filing of the bond of said Justice of the Peace, as provided in Section 1722 of the General Code.

Section 2. The sum of \$56.00 is hereby appropriated from the general fund for the payment of the premiums upon said bonds.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
