

## ORDINANCE NO. 8-42 ✓

Authorizing purchase of automobile for the use of the Police Department, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEALEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they hereby are authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of one automobile, being a 2-door Sedan, with standard equipment, heavy duty air cooled generator, adaptable to police cruiser work, and heavy duty battery sufficient for radio and other equipment, spare wheel, and rear compartment or trunk space sufficient to provide space for red cross equipment and blankets, the cost thereof not to exceed \$1200.00, and to exchange thereon one 1940 Hudson 2-door Sedan, Motor No. 4085628, or one 1930 Model A Standard Ford Coupe, Motor 3150741, together with all equipment thereon, except the siren, radio and heater, seller to transfer the heater to the new car.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement had according to law. The sum of \$1200.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the purpose aforesaid.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the Safety Department is in immediate need of said automobile and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
