

RESOLUTION NO. 8-42 ✓

Providing for cancellation of bond of Auditor.

Whereas, S. W. Roderick, as Auditor elect for the term beginning January 1st, 1942 and ending December 31st, 1945, did heretofore execute and file his official bond in the sum of \$25,000.00 effective January 1st, 1942 with The Travelers Indemnity Company as surety thereon, and

whereas, said bond was originally issued and filed in error, and a new bond has been submitted by said Auditor with surety thereon acceptable to the City of Bexley and approved by the Mayor, effective as of the first day of January, 1942, and covering the full term of said Auditor, and

whereas, it is the desire of said The Travelers Indemnity Company to be relieved of responsibility upon its said bond by reason of said error in the issuing and filing thereof, and said Company has offered to refund to the City the full amount of premium here tofore paid by the City for said bond, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

That upon receipt of the refund by said The Travelers Indemnity Company of the full amount of the premium heretofore paid by the City for the above bond of the Auditor, said bond shall be cancelled and said The Travelers Indemnity Company relieved from all liability accruing thereon from said first day of January, 1942, by reason of said error in the original issuing thereof, and the Mayor is hereby authorized and empowered to enter cancellation upon said bond.

The Clerk of Council is directed to forward a certified copy of this resolution to said the Travelers Indemnity Company.
