Burns Construction Company has completed the performance of its contract for resurfacing and repairing Sheridan Avenue from Livingston Avenue to Main Street, Remington Road from Livingston Avenue to Main Street, Remington Road from Maryland Avenue to Elm Avenue, and certain parts of other streets in the City, as specified in said contract, according to the terms thereof, and that said completion is to the satisfaction of said engineers. the Council does hereby accept said improvement and directs the Clerk of Council to issue to said Contractor a properly dated notice of acceptance thereof.
