

RESOLUTION NO. 11-42 ✓

Appointing board to report estimated assessment to pay the cost and expense of improving Columbus Avenue from Cassady Road to Stanwood Road.

Whereas, it has been determined by council to assess 81 $\frac{1}{3}$ % of the cost, less that portion of the cost which is to be performed and borne by the Work Projects Administration, and excepting the cost of water taps, for improving Columbus Avenue from Cassady Road to Stanwood Road, said assessment to be in proportion to the benefits which may result from said improvement, NOW, WHEREFORE:
BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEALEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Jas. Dixey, Herman Mlocke and Jas. Butcher, three disinterested free-holders of said City, be and they are hereby appointed a Board to estimate the assessment of such cost on the lots and lands to be charged therewith, as set forth in an Ordinance No. 75-41, to improve said street, passed December 9, 1941, in proportion as nearly as may be to the benefits which may result from the improvement to the several lots or parcels of land so assessed and report to this council the said estimated assessment.
