ORDINANCE NO. 14-42

Authorizing the purchase and installation of traffic control signal light at the intersection of East Broad Street and Remington Road, and declaring an emergency. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BENLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That a traffic control signal light shall be erected at the intersection of East Broad Street and Remington Road; and the Mayor and Auditor be and hereby are authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of such traffic control signal light, and to cause the same to be installed at the above location.

Section 2. The sum of \$450.00 is hereby appropriated from the Streets Maintenance and Repair Gasoline Tax Fund for the above purpose.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that a serious traffic hazard exists at the above location, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
