

## ORDINANCE NO. 15-42 ✓

Providing for the position of Equipment Maintenance Mechanic, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEAVER, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the position of Equipment Maintenance Mechanic is hereby created, which position shall be exempt from the classified service. An Equipment Maintenance Mechanic shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by council for the remainder of the year beginning April 1, 1942, and ending December 31st, 1942, and thereafter such appointment shall be for a term of one year, or until his successor is appointed and qualified. The salary shall be at the rate of \$195.00 per month payable monthly out of the General Fund. Said Equipment Maintenance Mechanic shall have charge of the maintenance, care and repair of all traffic control signals and devices, and of all motor vehicles and other machinery, equipment and tools belonging to the City and used in any departments of the City Government.

Section 2. The sum of \$1950.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the payment of the salary of said office for the year 1942.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that much of the machinery and equipment of the city is in the need of immediate repair and said ordinance shall go into full force and effect upon the passage thereof.
