BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF  
OHIO:

Section 1. That the salary of Assistant Superintendent  
of Streets be and is hereby fixed at the rate of \$160.00 per  
month, payable monthly, out of the General Fund.

Section 2. This ordinance is an emergency measure,  
necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,  
health and safety, and the same shall go into immediate force  
and effect.
