

RESOLUTION NO. 18-42 ✓

Authorizing removal of traffic light at Parkview Avenue and Broad Street, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That at the request of the Chief of the Office of Defense Transportation, the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to remove the traffic signal light located at the intersection of Parkview Avenue and Broad Street.

Section 2. This resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace and safety, said emergency being that said light is delaying War Defense Workers, for which reason said resolution shall go into immediate force and effect.
