Appropriating moneys for Civilian Defense purposes.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That for the purpose of paying costs and expenses incident to Civilian Defense there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of \$1500.00 from the General Fund.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
