Providing for purchase of a truck for Department of Public Service, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of a used automobile truck with pick-up body for the use of the Department of Public Service for street repair purposes at a cost not to exceed \$450.00.

Section 2. The sum of \$450.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the above purpose.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said truck is necessary for the immediate repair of public highways in the city, and said ordinance shall go into force and effect upon passage thereof.
