That the Mayor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized to purchase one used International truck chassis equipped with four 6.00 x 16 six ply tires, with heater and defroster, same to cost not over \$477.00, and to exchange thereon one 1931 Chevrolet chassis No. OL2076, motor number V2127098, at a price of \$25.00, leaving a net cash balance to be paid of \$452.00, which sum is hereby appropriated from the general fund for the above purpose.

Section 2. This ordinance is an emergency measure for the reason that said chassis is necessary in the daily operation of the Parks Department of the City, and the same shall go into immediate force and effect.
