Authorizing the Mayor and Auditor to purchase two controllers, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and hereby are authorized to enter into a contract to purchase from the Hagle Signal Corporation two HA50A controllers for traffic lights, one of which is to be used at the intersection of Broad street and Parkview Avenue, and the other to hold for emergency repairs, at a cost of not to exceed \$140.00 for each controller.

Section 2. That the sum of \$280.00 is hereby appropriated from the Street, Maintenance and Repair, Gasoline Tax Fund for the above surpose.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that aid controllers are necessary for the present operation of traffic signal lights, and the same shall go into immediate force and effect.
