

ORDINANCE NO. 43-42 ✓

Providing for refund of building permit fee.

Whereas, on March 8, 1942 a building permit was issued to T. E. Ochs, contractor for W. R. Childress, for building on premises at 318 W. Ardmore Road, being permit no. 4386, for which permit a fee of \$2.00 was paid by said T. E. Ochs, which amount has been deposited to the credit of General Fund, and

whereas, said permittee has not constructed the building provided for in said permit, and desires to surrender said permit and has requested repayment of the fee paid therefor, and

whereas, Council is of the opinion that said fee should be refunded, NOW, WHEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the fee in the sum of \$2.00 heretofore paid by T. E. Ochs for permit no. 4386 be and the same is hereby refunded upon the cancellation and surrender of said permit, and the Auditor is authorized to pay the same out of General Fund, and the sum of \$2.00 is hereby appropriated from said fund for that purpose.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
