BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BENLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the engineers having reported to this Council that the Electric Power Equipment Company has completed the performance of its contract for the construction and installation of a system of lighting for Fair Avenue between Remington Road and Gould Road according to the terms thereof and to the satisfaction of the engineers, and said engineers have filed their final estimate on said improvement and recommended payment thereof to said contractor, the Council does hereby accept said improvement and directs the Clerk of Council to issue to said contractor a properly dated notice of the acceptance thereof, and does hereby authorize the payment of said final estimate.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
