

ORDINANCE NO. 49-42 ✓

Authorizing the purchase by the City of the bonds of the City of Bexley in the sum of \$17,800.00.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That whereas, there are moneys in the treasury which will not be required to be used by the municipality for a period of six months or more, and whereas, the bonds of the City are being issued in the sum of \$17,800.00 under authority of Ordinance No. 47-42, passed September 8, 1942, providing for such issue of bonds in anticipation of the collection of special assessments for the improvement of the following streets, to-wit:

Roosevelt Avenue from Main Street to Fair Avenue
Dale Avenue from Parkview Avenue to Dawson Avenue
Merkle Road from Fair Avenue to Powell Avenue,

and it will be for the best interests of the City to invest said funds in said bonds, it is hereby determined and ordered that the Auditor be, and he is hereby requested and directed to submit to the Mayor and the City Solicitor a statement of the moneys in the treasury, or in the process of collection, and a schedule showing the probable requirements of money for the use of the municipality for a period of not less than six months, together with his recommendations as to whether said moneys in the treasury shall be invested in such bonds, and in the event that he shall so recommend, the Mayor, Auditor and Solicitor are hereby authorized and empowered to make such investment at not more than par and accrued interest, said bonds not having been taken by the Sinking Fund Trustees.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
