Authorizing the purchase of controllers and repairs for traffic lights located at the intersection of Parkview Avenue with Main Street and Broad Street.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and hereby are authorized to enter into contracts for the purchase of controllers and other necessary repairs for the traffic lights located at the intersections of Parkview Avenue with Main Street and Broad Street.

Section 2. That the sum of \$272.00 is hereby appropriated from the Streets Maintenance and Repair Gasoline Tax Fund for the above purpose.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
