Providing for appropriation of funds.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the following appropriation of funds be and the same are hereby authorized, to-wit:

1. From the general fund to the auditor's fund 1-D5 the sum of \$200.00
2. From the service fund to the sewer 4Q7 fund the sum of \$200.00.
3. From the water fund to the labor pay roll fund 4F1 the sum of \$200.00

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
