ORDINANCE NO. 59-42

Providing for expense in connection with Solicitor's office.

Whereas, the City does not maintain a separate office for the conduct of the official duties of the City Solicitor, and it is necessary that the Solicitor perform the duties thereof in his private office at expense to himself, which expenses should be borne by the City, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$25.00 per month be paid to the Solicitor in addition to his salary to cover the expense of office rentals, supplies and clerical services, said sum to be paid quarter-annually out of General Fund, which amount is hereby appropriated from said Fund for that purpose.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. 9-33, passed March 28, 1933, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
