RESOLUTION NO. 5-43

By Mr. Steplan

Declaring it necessary to construct sanitary sewer in part of Sanitary Sewer District No. 5, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEALEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That it is necessary to construct a certain part hereinafter described of the canitary severs provided for in a general plan for a system of severage for the City of Bewley, which general plan was adopted by Council on the 11th day of June, 1918, and is now on file in the office of the Mayor; that the portion of the work provided for in said general plan which it is hereby determined to construct, is as follows, to-wit: The capitary sewer shown upon the plan of said Sewer District No. 5, as follows:

An eight (8) inch samitary sewer in Delmar Drive beginning at the end of the present sewer, being westerly 109 feet from the present manhole in Stanwood Road, running thence westerly in said Delmar Drive a distance of 203 feet.

That part of said sever district so to be i proved, being all the lots and lands bounding, abutting and fronting upon said improvement.

Be it further resolved that said sever, together with necessary "Y" Brenches for each lot fronting and abutting upon said improvement, shall be constructed in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles on file in the office of the Mayor, and shall be of vitrified pipe.

Section 2. Be it further resolved that the entire cost of said improvement shall be paid by the City of Bexley out of the general fund, and a proper charge shall hereafter be fixed by Council for the privilege of connecting with and using said sewer, said charge to be paid by the respective owners of the properties bounding and abutting upon said improvement at the time of tapping into said sewer and connecting their respective properties therewith, and the amounts so charged therefor shall be deposited in the

general fund and credited to the cost of said sewer; that this resolution be published by posting in the five places provided for posting resolutions, ordinances, etc.

Section 3. That Resolution No. 16-42 be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 4. This resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and salety, said emergency being that the houses on premises fronting on said improvement are without sanitary sewerage, and this resolution shall go into immediate force and effect. \
