Section 2. That the total assessment against each lot or parcel of land shall be payable in cash within thirty days from and after the passage of this ordinance, or at the option of the owner, in five annual installments with interest at the same rate as shall be borne by the bonds to be issued in anticipation of the collection of the same, to-wit: 3%. All cash payments shall be made to the Auditor of said City of Bexley. All assessments and

installments thereof remaining unpaid at the expiration of said thirty days shall be certified by the Clerk of this Council to the County Auditor, as provided by law to be by him placed on the tax duplicate and collected as other taxes are collected.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
