## ORDINANCE NO. 15-43 \*

By Mr. Stephan

Providing penalty for injury to gardens or garden produce.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That whoever, not being the owner thereof, steals, tramples, cuts, or in any manner injures or destroys any vegetable, fruit, berry or cereal plant, tree or vine, or any part thereof, or in any manner destroys, injures or defaces the garden or patch of ground in which the same has been planted, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in an amount not to exceed \$50.00, together with the costs of prosecution.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
