

ORDINANCE NO. 17-43

By Mr. Altmaier:

Authorizing acceptance of funds from Bexley Park Road Improvement Association.

Whereas, The Bexley Park Road Improvement Association has on hand a balance of monies heretofore collected from persons then residing on Bexley Park Road for the purpose of improving said street and caring for the trees and parkways therein, said balance being in the sum of \$279.53, also Certificate Number 1859 issued by The Columbian Building & Loan Association for the original sum of \$353.78 on which certificate 83% has heretofore been paid upon liquidation, and

Whereas, it is the desire of said Association to transfer said funds to the City of Bexley to be used so far as practicable in the improvement and care of Bexley Park Road and the parkways, shrubbery and trees therein, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Auditor be and hereby is authorized to accept from said Bexley Park Road Improvement Association said sum of \$279.53 and said certificate of deposit, and deposit said moneys and the proceeds from said certificate of deposit when received in the General Fund, from which said fund there shall be appropriated from time to time necessary monies for the improvement of Bexley Park Road and the care of the parkways, shrubbery and trees therein.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
