Providing for refund of balance of monies deposited by Wallace F. Ackley and Frederick Schiefer for deposit for cost of alley improvement.

Whereas, on the 14th day of October, 1941 this Council adopted Resolution No. 21-41, finding it necessary to improve the first alley east of Chelsea Avenue from Main Street to Charles Street in co-operation with the Work Projects Administration, in which resolution it was recited that it was represented that there would be paid into the Treasury by and on behalf of the owners of the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon the east side of said proposed improvement prior to the letting of a contract for materials for said improvement, and prior to the commencement of any work upon said improvement, such sums of money, to be estimated by the engineers, as would pay for that portion of the work which would be attributable to and assessible against the following lots and lands bounding and abutting said improvement upon the east side thereof, to-wit: being all the lots on the east side of said improvement from Main Street to and including the 7th lot south of Astor Avenue, under an agreement to be entered into whereby said funds should be used for the purchase of materials for and to pay expenses of said improvement, and that said improvement should not be undertaken unless and until said funds were so paid into the City Treasury, and providing that that part of said cost apportioned to the lots lying upon the east side of said improvement between the above points should be payable out of the amounts therein provided to be deposited in the City Treasury for that purpose, and any excess over and above such sums so apportioned to said lots to be refunded to the persons making such deposits, which said deposits were required by council by reason of the fact that said lots were outside the corporate limits of the City of Bexley, and

Whereas, there was on the 18th day of February, 1942 paid into the City Treasury for the above purpose the following sums by the

following persons, to-wit: Frederick Schiefer \$225.00, to apply on the costs apportioned to lot No. 1 of Benley Annex, and Wallace F. Ackley \$2775.00, to apply upon the amount apportioned to all other lots between Main Street and the 7th lot south of Astor Avenue, being the amounts estimated by the engineers for said purposes, and whereas, such legislation and proceedings were had that said improvement was made in accordance with said resolution of necessity and the costs of said improvement which would have been properly assessible or apportioned against the lots and lands hereinabove described lying on the east side of said improvement between Main Street to and including the 7th lot south of Astor Avenue, had said lots been within the corporate limits, have been by the engineers and the assessing board determined as follows, to-wit:

said improvement against each lot as aforesaid, there remains a

balance of \$173.02 out of the \$225.00 so deposited by Frederick Schiefer, and the sum of \$899.29 out of the amount so deposited by wallace F. Ackley, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEALEY, STATE OF CHIO:

Section 1. That the Auditor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to apply, out of the funds so deposited by Frederick Schiefer, the sum of \$51.98, and out of the funds so deposited by Wallace F. Ackley, the sum of \$1875.71, to the costs of said improvement so determined to be applicable to the above described lots and parts of lots; and that upon the execution of proper receipts and releases by the said Frederick Schiefer and the said Wallace F. Ackley, the Auditor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue his voucher to said Frederick Schiefer for said unexpended balance in the sum of \$173.02, and his voucher to the said Wallace F. Ackley in said unexpended balance of \$899.29, payable out of the funds so deposited by said respective parties, and which funds are hereby appropriated for said purposes.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
