WHEREAS, Council is of the opinion that said former payment of \$91.85 did not result in any benefit to the property owners along said street and that same should not be assessed as a part of the costs of said improvement and that said Powell Avenue improvement fund should be reimbursed for said payment, now, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That said Powell Avenue improvement fund
