

ORDINANCE NO. 1-44

Providing for the appointment of an Acting Superintendent of Building, and declaring an emergency.

Whereas, Howard Anthony, the Superintendent of Building, is absent from the city by reason of his having been called into the active Military Service of the United States, which absence is for an indefinite period, and it is necessary that certain duties in connection with said office be performed from time to time during such absence, and whereas, due to conditions resulting from the existing state of war the construction of buildings has fallen off to such an extent that such duties can be performed by the Superintendent of Streets, in connection with his regular duties, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BARTLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That during the absence of the Superintendent of Building, as hereinabove set forth, and until further order of Council, the duties of said office of such Superintendent of Building as provided by Ordinance No. 95-31, passed December 22nd, 1931, and amendments thereto, shall be performed by the Superintendent of Streets, Willard A. Montgomery, as Acting Superintendent of Building. Said Acting Superintendent of Building shall receive no salary as such, and he shall give bond for the faithful performance of his duties in the sum of \$500.00, the premium for which shall be paid by the City.

Section 2. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that there is no official at present authorized to issue building permits and to perform the other duties of said office of Superintendent of Building, for which reason this ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
