RESOLUTION OF MUNICIPALITY PROPOSING TO COOPERATE
WITH THE DIRECTOR OF HIGHWAYS

WHEREAS, the public interest demands the improvement herein-
after described, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Xenley, State of Ohio,
desires to cooperate with the Director of Highways of the State
of Ohio, in accomplishing said improvement:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of
Xenley, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the public interest demands the
improvement, under the provisions of Section 1189 and related
sections of the General Code of Ohio, of that part of State
Highway No. 1, situated in the City of Xenley, County of Franklin,
and State of Ohio, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the east end of bridge over Alum Creek;
thence East along East Main Street to the East Cor-
poration line of the City of Xenley, a distance of
approximately 1.03 miles, said improvements to con-
sist of resurfacing for full width of street with
bituminous concrete, 2" minimum thickness and necessary
repairs to base.

Section 2. That the Council of the City of Xenley,
State of Ohio, does hereby propose to cooperate with the Director
of Highways of the State of Ohio, in the improvement of the
above described portion of State Highway No. 1, by assuming
and contributing 50% of construction costs which shall include
the cost of resetting to grade all sewer manhole covers and
valve boxes.

Section 3. That this resolution be and remain in
force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
