## ORDINANCE NO. 8-44 :

By Mr. O. F. Rehn

Providing for two weeks leave of absence, with pay for employees who are called into the Armed Services of the United States.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That all appointive employees, and all employees in the classified services of the city, who have heretofore been, or hereafter shall be inducted into any of the Armed Services of the United States under the provisions of the Selective Service Act, be and they hereby are granted a two weeks leave of absence, with full pay, and the Auditor is hereby authorized to issue proper vouchers therefor.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
