
Appropriating money for the payment of salary of Director of Recreation, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:


Section 1. That there is hereby appropriated to the use of the Recreation Board for the payment of salary of the Director of Recreation, the sum of \$250.00 from the general fund.

Section 2. This ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of peace, health and safety, for which reason the same shall go into immediate force and effect for the passage thereof.




